9 Feb	Stayman	Nil experience	Knows when and how to bid Stayman and the responses to determine if there is a 4/4 fit in the major suit(s) Included garbage Stayman
16 Feb	Defensive 2nd and 3rd hand play	1 year experience	Improving the way you play the cards when defending a contract
23 Feb	Opener rebids	2 years experience	Understands when a rebid is invitational versus game force
2 Mar	Opening Leads	Nil experience	Understands basic opening leads in suit and NT contracts
9 Mar	Play techniques	1 year experience	Can finesse, establish a long suit and has an idea of how to promote honours
16 Mar	Play techniques	2 years experience	Managing bad suit breaks and when to duck lead
23 Mar	Declarer play in suit contracts	Nil experience	Can count losers, better manage trumps, knows how best to continue play after drawing trumps
30 Mar	Signals and Discards	1 year experience	Understands what the lead of an honour and the lead/discard of both a high and low card means
6 Apr	Rubber bridge	Nil experience	Understands Rubber bridge tactics, play and scoring

If the topic in the table makes no sense to you, you should start at the Nil experience level. If you are a 2016 learner, we recommend just attending the Nil experience lessons. Each lesson will include a short presentation and then practice.
